## **Summary:**

- Further cross-border air strikes by Sudan and the military takeover of the Heglig oil field by South Sudanese forces raised fears of a return to unrestrained hostilities.
- Despite three air strikes over the past week in Bentiu (Unity) international agencies are carrying out day-to-day activities and will remain in the area as long as it is safe to do so. The ETC continues to provide connectivity services in this area.

## **Cluster Responsibilities:**

• WFP is leading ETC activities in South Sudan with responsibility for coordination, implementation and overall operation support for common ICT services.

#### **Achievements:**

- The ETC response solution, composed of the emergency.lu and Ericsson Response WIDER systems, continues to provide free internet connectivity and voice telephony services in Maban (Upper Nile), Pibor (Jonglei) and Renk (Upper Nile).
  - To date, 1370 users from 154 different organizations having been registered to use the ETC services.
- The system in Bentiu (Unity) is being dismantled and will be returned to the Government of Luxembourg. The ETC will continue to provide connectivity services to the humanitarian community in Bentiu through alternate means.
- The ETC response solution in Pibor now has an air-conditioner which prevents the system from overheating. This means that connectivity services can now be provided whenever the generators are running.

#### **Challenges and Gaps:**

- The ETC remains critically underfunded. With the recent decision by the Humanitarian Country Team to move to 'Crisis Response' mode, funding is desperately needed to provide ICT services to expanding humanitarian operations.
- The HISP (Humanitarian Internet Service Provider) project to provide reliable long-term services at lower running costs to the relief community has not yet begun due to lack of funding.



### **Planned Activities:**

• The ETC response solution is only a temporary resolution to connectivity issues in remote locations. The equipment in Pibor will be decommissioned in May 2012.

## **Meetings:**

Global ETC teleconferences on RoSS will be held on an as-needed basis. Operational updates will be shared via bi-weekly ETC SitReps.
