

Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan ETC Situation Report #5 Reporting period 16/11/13

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Highlights

- An inter-agency ICT assessment was conducted in Roxas by representatives from ETC, NetHope, Save the Children and NetHope.
- Two additional technicians from Ericsson Response arrived in Tacloban as part of the ETC team.

Achievements

TACLOBAN

 ETC Response Solution installed in Tacloban City Hall continued to provide Wi-Fi connectivity to staff from nearly 20 different humanitarian organisations.

CEBU

- ETC in Cebu has been allocated its own dedicated space on the ramp at the airport for equipment
 waiting to be cleared. The Logistics cluster has also allocated space for the ETC in one the two
 rubhalls for storage set-up at the airport.
- ETC is providing basic internet and printing services to WFP and UNHCR from Waterfront Hotel in Cebu.

Challenges and Gaps

TACLOBAN

Lack of power supply in Tacloban is posing a challenge to ETC operations. Additional equipment generators and solar panels – are being shipped. Suspected contaminated fuel is also causing
problems with generators already in country.

Planned Activities

TACLOBAN



 ETC team in Tacloban is working on establishing microwave links to extend Wi-Fi coverage from City Hall.

CEBU

- ETC in Cebu is planning to provide a simple simplex network which will enable radio communications between Waterfront Hotel, the dedicated ETC rubhall and base operations at the airport. This will be tested once equipment arrives from Manila.
- ETC in Cebu is currently using shared hotel ISP with on 5MB down, 1MB up but is also seeking its own ISP link to provide services.
- Due to the lack of power supply in operational areas, the ETC is looking to deploy an electrician to support the response.
- 12 tons of equipment arrived from Dubai which includes electrical, telecoms and IT equipment to be separated and shipped to Tacloban and other operational locations.

ROXAS

Following the assessment mission, the ETC plans to provide shared services in Roxas City at a
humanitarian operations centre in Capiz Government Business Centre. This will include setting up
a VSAT for voice and data connectivity, security communications, electrical support and help desk
services.
