

Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan ETC Situation Report #6 Reporting period 17/11/13

Highlights

- The ETC team in Tacloban is now providing data connectivity to the OSOCC at the sports stadium.
- Approximately 150 humanitarian personnel have accessed data services provided by the ETC in Tacloban.
- Additional responder from Ericsson Response has arrived in Manila.

Achievements

TACLOBAN

- A wireless link has been established between the ETC Response Solution set up at Tacloban City Hall and the OSOCC at the sports stadium providing the latter with Wi-Fi internet connectivity.
- ETC has installed WIDER technology by Ericsson Response as part of the ETC Response Solution. WIDER is a central globalised management solution that provides secure network access and allows for monitoring use of internet services. WIDER requires users to create an account which provides them with access at any location where ETC services are provided.

Challenges and Gaps

TACLOBAN

Lack of power is a challenge for ETC operations.

Planned Activities

TACLOBAN

- ETC team is setting up access points to cover IHP camp, NGO building and the OSOCC at Tacloban stadium
- The VHF radio network will be extended to increase coverage area.



CEBU

 An ICT assessment will be carried out in the northern part of Cebu island to determine requirements of the humanitarian community.

ROXAS

- Following the assessment mission to Roxas, the ETC plans to provide shared services at a
 humanitarian operations centre in Capiz Government Business Centre. Services will be provided
 in partnership with Ericsson Response, NetHope and NetHope partner British Telecom for an
 initial period of three months.
- An ETC team will deploy to Roxas this week, along with ETC partners Ericsson Response and VSAT engineers from British Telecom, to carry out the installation.

ORMOC and GUIUAN

 An inter-agency assessment mission will take place on Monday 18 November to determine connectivity and security communications coverage.
