

# Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan ETC Situation Report #7 Reporting period 18/11/13

# **Highlights**

Over 150 relief workers from 24 different humanitarian organizations are provided with Wi-Fi
internet connectivity at the City hall, the NGO building and the stadium (OSOCC and IHP camp)
in Tacloban.

# **Achievements**

#### **TACLOBAN**

- The ETC team in Tacloban has extended data connectivity services to the City hall, NGO building and the OSOCC and IHP camp at the stadium.
- The data connectivity solution is supported by the emergency.lu VSAT and the Ericsson Response WIDER technology. Once users create an account, they can access internet at any location where ETC services are provided.

#### ORMOC

An ETC assessment is being conducted on Monday 18 November. ETC report to follow.

#### CEBU

 Additional ICT equipment was received to support the ETC operation. Some equipment has already been sent to Tacloban.

# **Challenges and Gaps**

Lack of power remains a challenge for ETC operations.

# **Planned Activities**

#### **TACLOBAN**

Wireless coverage is planned to be established at Tacloban airport.



The VHF radio network will be extended to increase coverage area.

#### **CEBU**

- An ICT assessment will be carried out in the northern part of Cebu Island to determine requirements of the humanitarian community.
- ETC is planning to establish an Internet Café at the Logistics hub in the airport.

#### ROXAS

- The ETC team is preparing deployment of shared data connectivity services to Roxas for an initial period of three months. The equipment is provided by NetHope partner, British Telecom.
- Technicians from British Telecom and ETC partners will carry out the installation at the humanitarian operations centre in Capiz Government Business Centre.

#### **GUIUAN**

 An inter-agency assessment mission is planned to be conducted this week to determine common ICT requirements.
