

Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan ETC Situation Report #14 Reporting period 25/11/13

Highlights

- NetHope and partner BT (British Telecom) deployed to Borongan to set up data connectivity services at the Provincial Government Building.
- An ETC team composed of emergency.lu, Ericsson Response and WFP staff installed the Regular emergency.lu kit in Guiuan to expand Internet access.

Achievements

BORONGAN

• NetHope and partner BT arrived in Borongan and identified the Provincial Government Building as the location to set up the equipment to provide voice telephony and data connectivity services to the humanitarian community.

GUIUAN

- The emergency.lu Regular kit is now installed on the roof of the IOM building in order to better cover the IHP base camp.
- At the local coordination meeting, the team presented ETC operation in Philippines and services that will be provided to all humanitarian organizations in Guiuan.

TACLOBAN

- The ETC team has started to install an additional VHF repeater to increase the coverage area.
- 900 users are registered on to the ETC Network, benefiting from data connectivity and voice telephony services in Tacloban.

Challenges and Gaps

• Additional equipment is required to extend connectivity to further sites in Tacloban and Guiuan.

The ETC provides timely, predictable and effective Information Communications Technology services to support the humanitarian community in carrying-out their work efficiently, effectively and safely.



• In Tacloban, the Philippines Long Distance Telephone Company (PLDT) providing an Internet Fibre link is not providing required bandwidth capacity yet.

Planned Activities

BORONGAN

- The team plans to install the VSAT equipment at Provincial Government Building and identify ICT staff to support the installation once completed.
- On its way back from Borongan to Guiuan, NetHope and their partner BT will assess any potential sites for VHF repeater installation.

GUIUAN

- The ETC team will extend internet connectivity at the IHP base camp using the Ericsson Response WIDER, a secure authentication and traffic management solution.
- If time permits, the team is planning to assess requirements at the stadium, the new location for the IHP camp.

TACLOBAN

• The team plans to complete VHF repeater installation by 26/11/13. This will extend VHF network coverage in Tacloban.
