

Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan ETC Situation Report #15 Reporting period 26/11/13

Highlights

- Internet connectivity and voice telephony services are being provided to the humanitarian community at the Provincial Government Building in Borongan thanks to NetHope and partner BT (British Telecom).
- Local ISP has increased its Fibre link internet speed allowing over 1000 users to benefit from internet and voice telephony services in Tacloban.

Achievements

BORONGAN

- The equipment set up by NetHope and its partner BT is now fully operational at the Provincial Government Building providing voice telephony and data connectivity services to the humanitarian community.
- NetHope identified a site to install a VHF repeater between Borongan and Guiuan that could provide radio communication coverage for both municipalities.

GUIUAN

 The team conducted a quick assessment of the future IHP base camp to identify a location to move and re-install the emergency.lu Regular Deployment kit to continue provision of necessary voice telephony and data connectivity services there.

TACLOBAN

The PDLT Fibre link has now increased the bandwidth speed to downlink 30 Mb/s and uplink 30 Mb/s. Over 1000 users are being provided with Internet access and voice telephony services in Tacloban.

Challenges and Gaps

 Guiuan Internet installation needs to be revised to provide more stable connectivity and considering the future move of the IHP base camp.



 Radio communication is being extended in Tacloban City however the VHF repeater is not operating properly. The team is working on fixing the technical issue.

Planned Activities

GUIUAN

 The ETC team is evaluating best installation to ensure continuation of internet connectivity at the future IHP base camp with support from emergency.lu and Ericsson Response.

TACLOBAN

 Now the local ISP is reliable enough to connect organizations' offices and provide the required ETC services, the team is planning to pull out any VSAT equipment that was there as back up to be used in any other needed common operational locations.
