

## Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan

### ETC Situation Report #17

Reporting period 28/11/13

#### Highlights

- Internet access is made available to the humanitarian community across 6 locations including Guiuan, Roxas City, Estancia, Cebu and Tacloban serving more than 1370 users.
- The latest map showing ETC services across operational locations has now been made available to the humanitarian community.

#### Achievements

##### BORONGAN

- Internet connectivity and voice telephony services continue to be provided at the Provincial Government Building, through partnership with NetHope (and their partner BT).

##### GUIUAN

- Internet connectivity is provided to more than 70 users in Guiuan at the IHP camp.

##### CEBU

- The ETC team continues to dispatch ICT equipment to operational locations in Roxas, Tacloban and Guiuan.
- Five UN agencies have been provided with internet access at the new prefabricated shared offices at Cebu airport.

##### TACLOBAN

- Voice telephony and internet services using the local ISP and Ericsson Response WIDER system, are provided to over 1200 relief workers in Tacloban at City Hall, stadium and airport.

#### Challenges and Gaps

- ETC equipment is being delayed at the customs in Manila airport. Controls recently being strengthened could cause two-day to three-week delay on equipment deliveries.

- Delays in installing the VHF repeater to one of the towers in Tacloban (that is expected to provide city-wide VHF coverage)

## Planned Activities

### *BORONGAN*

- A VHF repeater is planned to be installed in a location identified between Borongan and Guiuan to provide radio communication coverage for both municipalities.
- ETC will start programming radios for the humanitarian organizations as per requests.

### *GUIUAN*

- The ETC team is setting up the emergency.lu Regular kit at the new IHP base camp and will configure the wireless equipment in order to replace the current setup.
- More equipment such as repeater, data kits and generators will be shipped on 29/11 in order to complete the installation of the VSAT and VHF network.

### *TACLOBAN*

- Radio programming will be provided in support of the humanitarian organizations using the common radio network.
