

## **Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan**

### **ETC Situation Report #20**

#### **Reporting period 05/12/13 to 08/12/13**

### **Highlights**

- 879 users have registered to use ETC internet services in Guiuan in addition to staff from local government offices, IOM and ICRC who are provided with internet access directly at their offices.
- ETC will support the deployment of the six NetHope Ku-band VSATs to NGO hubs in operational areas including Basey, Concepcion and Maya.

### **Achievements**

#### **GUIUAN**

- A telecommunications specialist from WFP FITTEST has been deployed to Guiuan to deploy the VHF radio network and put in place the plan to support humanitarian organizations with radio programming and training.
- Three new ETC staff arrived in Guiuan to focus on setting up the VHF network and providing ICT help desk support to humanitarian organizations.
- Two VHF repeaters with dedicated UN and NGO channels were installed at the main tower providing extended coverage across Guiuan. VHF handheld radio programming and training services also made available to humanitarian organisations.
- After some issues in setting up their own VSAT, ICRC is now being provided with internet connectivity from the ETC network. 40 staff members to be served by this service.
- The ETC met with OCHA to discuss supporting the OSOCC and OCHA operations with the extension of the wireless connectivity to the new humanitarian working space in view of the OSOCC relocation to new IHP camp.
- Wireless internet access was extended to the City Hall to support local government offices.
- ETC is providing advice to NGOs on procurement of VHF radio equipment.

#### **TACLOBAN**

- A new generator was installed at Tacloban Airport to support UNHAS operations.

- Power issues at the new OSOCC, UNDP and OCHA offices were fixed by the ETC electrician. A 500 KVA generator is now fully operational at the building.
  - The ETC has provided a map of humanitarian hubs to PDLT to look at using internet services from the local operator.
  - An assessment was conducted in Palo to support the Logistics hub with connectivity. The location will require a tower or mast to complete the installation.
  - The first local ETC meeting in Guiuan was held on 05/12. Participants agreed to meet every Thursday.

#### *CEBU*

- ICT equipment, including toolkits and access points, was shipped to Guiuan.
- The ETC is looking at new premises to store equipment in transit in Cebu. ETC logistician and coordinator visited a warehouse with the Logistics Cluster on 09/12.

#### *MANILA*

- The ETC coordinator met with UNDSS representative on 08/12. UNDSS is supporting the deployment of ETC radio network for humanitarian operations however there are no additional requirements in terms of security at this stage.

### **Challenges and Gaps**

- In Guiuan, the ETC network experienced some interruptions on 08/12 morning. The ETC network and links were stabilised by noon. The team is monitoring the installation.
- Some Ericsson Response equipment is still held in customs in Manila.

### **Planned Activities**

#### *GUIUAN*

- ETC plans to setup wireless internet and printing services at the new humanitarian working place when OSOCC relocates to new IHP base camp.
- ETC plans to support the humanitarian community with programming of VHF base and handsets radios.
- ETC will assist OCHA staff at the OSOCC with the installation of a Network Attached Storage (NAS) for the organization to manage files and information locally.
- Staff from stand-by partner MSB will be deployed to Guiuan on 10 Dec.

#### TACLOBAN

- ETC is planning to setup Internet connectivity at the Logistics base in Palo and install a new link at the new OSOCC.

#### CEBU

- ETC is looking at having an agreement with the Waterfront airport hotel to improve the Internet connectivity for the use of the humanitarian organizations operating there.
- Additional equipment such as Ericsson Response WIDER, access points and antennas will be shipped to Tacloban.

#### BORONGAN

- Plan International offered to support the installation of the wireless connections from the NetHope / BT VSAT located at the provincial government building to the provincial hospital.

#### BASEY

- One NetHope Ku-band VSAT is planned to be installed at the ICRC office (tbc) in Basey.

#### HERMANI

- ETC plans to conduct an assessment in Hermani to confirm the requirement of installing one of the NetHope Ku-band VSATs in support of the NGO community there.
