

Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan ETC Situation Report #23 Reporting period 17/12/13 to 20/12/13

Highlights

- Over 4,500 humanitarian workers have registered to use ETC internet services across operational
 hubs in the Philippines and this increasing every day. In addition the ETC has supported the
 installation of internet connectivity at local government offices.
- The VHF network is now fully operational in both Tacloban and Guiuan providing security telecommunications services to humanitarian workers on the ground. Two channels are being provided: one for UN agencies and one for NGOs.

Achievements

GUIUAN

- Radio training is being provided to humanitarian staff. To date 10 staff have received training.
- Wireless connectivity has been extended to the airport.
- The ETC continues to support the humanitarian community with the programming of VHF and vehicle radios.
- ETC continues to support humanitarian organizations with the procurement of VHF handsets through Global Humanitarian Services (GHS) based in WFP Dubai.
- Full-time ICT support at the OSOCC and IHP camp.
- The ETC is assisting with the installation of power supply infrastructure at the WFP office and camp.
- 1,485 users are registered on the ETC network. In addition, between 80 100 staff are connected to ETC internet via local government, ICRC and IOM offices.

TACLOBAN

• The Department of Health is now connected to the internet as is the Logistics Cluster warehouse in Palo.



- The VHF network is fully operational. Two channels are being provided: one for UN agencies and one for NGOs.
- The ETC continues to assist the humanitarian community with the programming of radios.
- The ETC has an agreement with PLDT in which PLDT will provide a 30MB fibre link to the ETC at
 no cost, however charges may start being applied in the near future. If so the ETC may have to
 convert operations to a cost recovery model.
 - The ETC continues to extend connectivity to humanitarian organizations via microwave link. To date support has been provided to ACF Spain, NCA, WHO, Samaritan's Purse, CARE International and WFP.
- Over 2,700 users are registered on the ETC network.

CEBU

- Electrical work at the new WFP office has finished.
- Negotiations are ongoing with PLDT to provide a fibre link at the new WFP office.
- WFP has decided to move into the second floor of the new office building rather than the fifth. This is a smaller area but is still equipped with ICT infrastructure.
- The ETC continues to assist the humanitarian community with the programming of radios.

ROXAS

- Greater bandwidth is now being provided at the humanitarian hub in the Capiz Provincial Capitol Building due to reconfiguration of WIDER and a switch from the VSAT to DSL.
 - o This will also improve bandwidth in Estancia and Borongan.
- Internet has now been provided to the National Food Authority (NFA).
- Providing connectivity to NGOs in the area is a priority.
- A VHF repeater is currently being installed. The site is good and will provide good coverage, potentially 20/30% of the island which will cover a number of NGO hubs.
- Humanitarian organizations have moved from the operational hub to various locations throughout Roxas.
- A VSAT will soon be deployed to Estancia to provide internet to the humanitarian community there.
- Ongoing ICT support to the humanitarian community and WFP.
- Over 500 users now registered on the ETC wireless network.



Challenges and Gaps

- Extensive damage to power grids in affected areas means that continuous access to electricity is
 a challenge. Power surges in Tacloban have also resulted in damaged equipment. ICT staff
 should advise their colleagues to use surge protectors.
- Access to fuel in certain areas is also a problem, restricting the use of generators.
- An electrician is required in Guiuan.

Planned Activities

ROXAS

- Installation of a repeater for expansion of the VHF network.
- Potential installation of an emergency.lu Rapid Deployment Kit at the Paon Beach Club in Estancia for provision of internet connectivity.

GUIUAN

- The ETC will assist with the demobilisation of the OSOCC camp.
- A radio coverage map will be developed.
- A complete inventory of ICT equipment in Guiuan will be carried out.
- Enable internet users to contact ICT helpdesk via email.

CEBU

Finalise new WFP office and move staff in.
