

Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan WFP ICT Situation Report #1 Reporting period 29/12/13

Highlights

• ICT infrastructure installation has been completed at the WFP/inter-agency offices in Cebu and Guiuan, as well as at the WFP office in Tacloban.

Achievements

CEBU

- ICT infrastructure installation has been completed at the WFP/inter-agency office and staff are moving in.
- Servers and SonicWalls for the WFP sub-offices have been received from Bangkok and Rome respectively. These will be shipped to the sub-offices ASAP.

TACLOBAN

- ICT infrastructure installation has been completed at the WFP office and staff are moving in.
- Generator installed at the new WFP office to ensure continuous power supply.
 - This is a temporary solution until external grade cabling is installed.
- Nine laptops and 15 M&E tablets have been delivered to the WFP office.

GUIUAN

- ICT infrastructure installation has been completed at the inter-agency office, managed by WFP, and staff are moving in.
- Helpdesk support to WFP staff is ongoing.

ROXAS

- WFP staff have moved into the NFA offices which have been connected to the internet.
 - An EMC VSAT will be installed to provide backup internet connectivity.
- Internet connectivity has been installed at the WFP warehouse.



• Helpdesk support to WFP is ongoing.

Challenges and Gaps

- A shipment of VoIP and internet equipment and printers from Dubai has been delayed.
- In Roxas, equipment for the WFP offices at the NFA premises has not yet been received.
- In Tacloban, equipment for the new VSAT due to be installed at the new WFP office has not yet been received.
 - Admin staff will renegotiate the lease with the landlord to allow installation of the VSAT on the roof of the new office.

Planned Activities

- VSATs to be installed at WFP offices in Roxas, Tacloban and Guiuan for backup internet connectivity.
- Installation of connectivity at the WFP warehouse in Tacloban.
- Delivery of additional equipment for the server room in the WFP office in Tacloban.
- Delivery of servers and SonicWalls to WFP sub-offices.
