

Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan ETC Situation Report #26 Reporting period 27/12/13 to 31/12/13

Highlights

- Over 5,300 users are now registered on ETC wireless networks across the affected areas.
- Inter-agency staff in Cebu have relocated from the Waterfront Hotel and prefabs to the new offices which have full internet connectivity, printing and helpdesk services.
- Inter-agency staff in Guiuan have relocated from the OSOCC camp to the new offices at the IHP camp which have full internet connectivity, printing and helpdesk services.
- An assessment was completed at the IFRC camp in Palo, Tacloban for planned installation of internet connectivity.
- A microwave internet link has been established between the new Save the Children offices and the ETC office in Tacloban.

Achievements

CEBU

 Inter-agency staff have relocated from the Waterfront Hotel and prefabs to the new offices which have full internet connectivity, printing and helpdesk services.

GUIUAN

- Inter-agency staff have relocated from the OSOCC camp to the new offices at the IHP camp which have full internet connectivity, printing and helpdesk services.
- The ETC continues to support the humanitarian community with the programming of VHF and vehicle radios.
- 1,623 users are now registered on the ETC wireless networks. Between 80-100 staff from government, ICRC and IOM offices are also utilising the network.
- Full-time ICT support at the IHP camp is ongoing.

TACLOBAN



- An assessment was completed at the IFRC camp in Palo for planned installation of internet connectivity.
- A microwave internet link has been established between the new Save the Children offices and the ETC office.
- An internet link between the Logistics Cluster warehouse in Palo and the new Samaritan's Purse
 office in Palo is being established.
- The ETC continues to liaise with PLDT regarding ISP connections for humanitarian organizations in Tacloban.
- 3,206 users are registered on the ETC wireless network.
- The ETC continues to assist the humanitarian community with the programming of radios and general ICT support.

ROXAS

- 556 users are now registered on the ETC wireless network.
- A VHF repeater is currently being installed. The site will provide good coverage, potentially 20/30% of the island. This will cover a number of NGO hubs.
- ICT support to the humanitarian community and WFP is ongoing.

Challenges and Gaps

GUIUAN

- An electrician is urgently required.
- Cement is also required to construct the foundation for the VSAT due to be installed at the WFP office for backup internet connectivity.

TACLOBAN

- Neil Murphy-Dewar, ETC Team Leader, has been medevac'd out with suspected Dengue fever.
 Consequently the team is understaffed as Noel Griffin was also medevac'd out with Dengue fever.
- Extensive damage to power grids means that continuous access to electricity is a challenge.
 Power surges have also resulted in damaged equipment. ICT staff should advise their colleagues to use surge protectors.
- Access to fuel in certain areas is also a problem, restricting the use of generators.
- An electrician is required for generator support.
- Cement is required to construct the foundation for the VSAT due to be installed at the WFP office for backup internet connectivity.



- The connectivity link between the Logistics Cluster warehouse and the new Samaritan's Purse
 office in Palo has not yet been established as equipment has not yet been configured. This will be
 resolved in the coming days.
- The mast in Palo is being heavily used for various microwave internet links. The mast may have to be rebuilt to improve performance of microwave links.

ROXAS

- The VHF repeater has not yet been installed as weather has not been suitable.
- Equipment for VSATs due to be installed for backup internet connectivity has not yet arrived.

ESTANCIA

 A Nethope VSAT arrived to replace the emergency.lu Rapid Deployment Kit, however a replacement LNB is required before it can be installed.

Planned Activities

ROXAS

• Installation of a repeater for expansion of the VHF network.

GUIUAN

- Installation of a VSAT at the WFP offices to provide backup internet connectivity.
- Planning will begin for an HF network and radio room.
- A radio coverage map will be developed.

TACLOBAN

- Establishment of internet connectivity to the IFRC offices in Palo.
- Inventory of VSAT equipment in Palo.
- Deployment of additional staff to replace Noel Griffin and Neil Murphy-Dewar.

ESTANCIA

 Shipment of a replacement LNB for the Nethope VSAT, which will then be installed as a replacement for the emergency.lu Rapid Deployment Kit.
