

Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan ETC Situation Report #27 Reporting period 31/12/13 to 03/01/14

Highlights

- ETC internet services are now being provided in 24 locations across six different towns to over 5,400 humanitarian workers.
- The ETC is providing wireless, printing and helpdesk services to inter-agency and WFP staff at new offices in Cebu, Guiuan and Tacloban.
- The ETC continues to establish new microwave internet links between its offices in Tacloban and organizations based in Palo, just outside the city. New internet connections have been provided to IFRC and Samaritan's Purse offices.

Achievements

CEBU

- The new inter-agency office is up and running and staff have moved in. The ETC is providing wireless, printing and helpdesk services.
 - To date, UNHAS, WHO, WFP and UNHCR staff have moved in. UNICEF and UNFPA have also expressed interest in moving staff in.

GUIUAN

- The inter-agency office is up and running and staff have moved in. The ETC is providing wireless, printing and helpdesk services.
- An electrician has arrived to assist with generator installation.
- An EMC VSAT has arrived and will be installed to provide backup connectivity for the WFP office as well as the inter-agency community.
- The ETC continues to support the humanitarian community with the programming of VHF and vehicle radios.
- Full-time ICT support at the IHP camp is ongoing.



TACLOBAN

- Internet connectivity has been established at the new Samaritan's Purse office and the IFRC office in Palo.
- The ETC continues to liaise with PLDT regarding ISP connections for humanitarian organizations in Tacloban.
- 3,311 users are registered on the ETC wireless network.
- The ETC continues to assist the humanitarian community with the programming of radios and general ICT support.

ROXAS

- A VHF repeater is currently being installed. The site will provide good coverage, potentially 20/30% of the island. This will cover a number of NGO hubs.
- ICT support to the humanitarian community and WFP is ongoing.

Challenges and Gaps

GUIUAN

- Certain materials are in short supply such as cables and connectors.
- Cement is required to construct the foundation for the VSAT due to be installed at the WFP office for backup internet connectivity.

TACLOBAN

- Extensive damage to power grids means that continuous access to electricity is a challenge.
 Power surges have also resulted in damaged equipment. ICT staff should advise their colleagues to use surge protectors.
- Access to fuel in certain areas is also a problem, restricting the use of generators.
- An electrician is required for generator support.
- Cement is required to construct the foundation for the VSAT due to be installed at the WFP office for backup internet connectivity.
- The mast in Palo is being heavily used for various microwave internet links. The mast may have to be rebuilt to improve performance of microwave links.

ROXAS

- The VHF repeater has not yet been installed as weather has not been suitable.
- Equipment for VSATs due to be installed for backup internet connectivity has not yet arrived.

ESTANCIA



 A Nethope VSAT arrived to replace the emergency.lu Rapid Deployment Kit, however a replacement LNB is required before it can be installed.

Planned Activities

GUIUAN

- Installation of the EMC VSAT at the WFP offices to provide backup internet connectivity.
- Planning will begin for an HF network and radio room.
- A radio coverage map will be developed.

TACLOBAN

- Internet connectivity will be provided to UNHCR following a request to the ETC.
- Inventory of VSAT equipment in Palo.
- Deployment of additional staff to replace Noel Griffin and Neil Murphy-Dewar.
- Potential rebuild of the mast in Palo to improve microwave internet connectivity.
- Provision of 24-hour electricity supply and security lighting to the Logistics Cluster warehouse in Palo.
- Recruitment of a diesel generator mechanic.

ROXAS

- Delivery of correct LNBs for Nethope VSATs.
- Finalize repeater installation for expansion of the VHF network.

ESTANCIA

- Shipment of a replacement LNB for the Nethope VSAT, which will then be installed as a replacement for the emergency.lu Rapid Deployment Kit.
- VHF will no longer be provided as radio services are not required.

CONCEPCION

Installation of a Nethope VSAT to provide internet for the humanitarian community.
