

Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan WFP ICT Situation Report #2 Reporting period 29/12/13 – 05/01/13

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Highlights

- ICT infrastructure installation has been completed at the WFP/inter-agency offices in Cebu and Guiuan, as well as at the WFP office in Tacloban. Internet, printing and helpdesk services are being provided.
- Laptops and tablets are being distributed to WFP staff to assist with office and field activities.
- VSATs are being installed in three locations to provide primary and backup internet connectivity for WFP.

Achievements

CEBU

- ICT infrastructure installation has been finalised at the new inter-agency offices and staff have moved in.
 - To date, WFP, WHO, UNHAS and UNHCR staff have moved in. UNFPA and UNCIEF have expressed interest.
- WFP server and SonicWall have been integrated into the network and the old server has been switched off.
- Ongoing ICT helpdesk support.

TACLOBAN

- ICT infrastructure installation has been finalised at the new WFP office and staff have moved in.
 - \circ There are currently 42 users registered on the ETC network there.
- Ten laptops have been distributed to WFP staff. Twelve more are due to arrive in the coming days.
- Seventeen tablets were received; 15 were distributed to WFP staff in Tacloban, three in Guiuan and two will be shipped to Roxas.



- A link from local ISP PLDT is being established at the new WFP office to replace the ETC link and provide a faster internet connection. Discussions with PLDT are ongoing.
- Approval has been acquired from the landlord of the WFP office building for installation of a VSAT on the roof of the new WFP office.
 - This VSAT will be used to provide backup internet connectivity.
- A generator was installed at the WFP office in order to provide continuous power during working hours.
- Ongoing ICT helpdesk support.

GUIUAN

- A VSAT has arrived which will be installed to provide the WFP office with its own internet connection.
- Process developed to provide WFP staff with SIM card top-ups.
- Three tablet computers have been distributed to humanitarian workers for use on distribution sites.
- Ongoing ICT helpdesk support.

ROXAS

- Servers and a SonicWall have been installed at the WFP offices at the NFA premises and the network switchover to SonicWall is in progress.
- An EMC VSAT has arrived and will be used to provide backup internet connectivity at the WFP offices.
- Ongoing ICT helpdesk support.

Challenges and Gaps

• Difficulties are being experienced with the recruitment of national staff. Out of a number of potential candidates, only one has so far accepted an offer of work from WFP.

CEBU

• There is currently no fixed IP.

TACLOBAN

- Equipment for the WFP server room is still missing.
- More staff will be required to replace Ericsson Response staff who will be leaving.



ROXAS

- A system schematic or installation manual is required to install the EMC VSAT.
- Specialised tools are also required to install the VSAT however they cannot be purchased locally.
- There is currently no fixed IP.
- Toner is required for the printers and racks and a UPS have not arrived.

Planned Activities

CEBU

- Finalise the handover report and the network diagram.
- Work with PLDT to acquire a fixed IP and finalise activation of RODC.

TACLOBAN

- Obtain equipment for server room.
- Finalise installation of PLDT fibre link at WFP offices.
- Installation of connectivity at the WFP warehouse.

GUIUAN

• Installation of VSAT for WFP-exclusive connectivity.

ROXAS

- Await delivery of instruction manual and install EMC VSAT for backup connectivity.
- Work with PLDT to acquire a fixed IP for a VPN and RODC setup.
