

Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan ETC Situation Report #28 Reporting period 03/01/14 to 13/01/14

Highlights

- ETC internet services are now being provided in 30 locations across nine towns and cities.
- Internet connectivity has now been established for the humanitarian community in Bogo City, Bantayan Island and Concepcion
- In Tacloban, internet connectivity has been extended to the UNHCR office and the WFP warehouse.
- A VHF repeater has been installed in Roxas providing security telecommunications services to the humanitarian community.

Achievements

CEBU

 To date five organizations have moved into the new inter-agency offices: UNHAS, WHO, WFP, UNHCR and UNFPA. UNICEF has also expressed interest in moving in. The ETC is providing wireless, printing and helpdesk services.

GUIUAN

- The electrical networks of the IHP camp and the inter-agency office are being integrated.
- Construction of a prefab in which to store equipment is ongoing.
- Installation of an EMC VSAT is ongoing. This will provide primary connectivity for the WFP office and backup connectivity for the inter-agency office.
- John Jeffries, an electrician from Irish Aid, has joined the team.
- The ETC continues to provide wireless, printing and helpdesk services at the inter-agency and WFP offices.
- The ETC continues to support the humanitarian community with the programming of VHF and vehicle radios.



TACLOBAN

- Internet connectivity has been established at the UNHCR office and WFP warehouse.
- The ETC continues to liaise with PLDT regarding ISP connections for humanitarian organizations in Tacloban.
- The ETC continues to assist the humanitarian community with the programming of radios and general ICT support.

ROXAS

- A VHF repeater has been installed and is providing security telecommunications services to the humanitarian community. Radio training and radio programming services are also being offered.
 - In the last few days however, the repeater has not been fully functional due to lack of power from the solar panels; a result of cloudy weather.
- WIDER has been reconfigured which has increased bandwidth for humanitarian workers.
- ICT support to the humanitarian community and WFP is ongoing.

ESTANCIA

 A NetHope VSAT has been installed as a replacement for the emergency.lu Rapid Deployment Kit which has been decommissioned and shipped out.

CONCEPCION

 Internet connectivity has now been installed for the humanitarian community at Jun Bee Recreation Centre.

BOGO CITY

Internet connectivity has now been installed for the humanitarian community at the World Vision
office.

BANTAYAN ISLAND

 Internet connectivity has now been installed for the humanitarian community at Adelaida Pension House.

Challenges and Gaps

GUIUAN

Certain materials are in short supply such as cables and connectors.

TACLOBAN



- Extensive damage to power grids means that continuous access to electricity is a challenge.
 Power surges have also resulted in damaged equipment. ICT staff should advise their colleagues to use surge protectors.
- Access to fuel in certain areas is also a problem, restricting the use of generators.

ROXAS

• Cloudy weather conditions have meant that the solar panels have not been sufficiently charged to power the VHF repeater which is consequently not fully operational.

Planned Activities

GUIUAN

- Complete installation of the EMC VSAT.
- Complete integration of IHP camp and inter-agency office electrical networks.
- Complete prefab construction.
- Assessment missions to Borongan and Salcedo to determine VHF requirements.
- Planning will begin for an HF network and radio room.
- A radio coverage map will be developed.

ROXAS

Documentation of ICT services in preparation for handover.
