

# Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan ETC Situation Report #30 Reporting period 29/01/14 to 12/02/14

# **Highlights**

• Local internet service providers are recovering from the typhoon and restoring connectivity. In those areas with reliable local connectivity, the ETC has migrated users from ETC wireless networks. In Tacloban, users in three sites have been migrated to local networks.

# **Achievements**

#### **GUIUAN**

- 3G internet connectivity is now available via local ISP Globe with speeds of up to 4 Mbps.
- VHF coverage is now available between Guiuan and Tacloban.
- Prefabs in which to store ICT and electrical equipment have been constructed.

## **TACLOBAN**

- Users in three sites have been migrated from ETC wireless networks to the local ISP PLDT as commercial internet services are restored across the city. A further two sites are expected to be migrated over the coming week.
  - The ETC is recovering equipment in those sites in which users have been migrated to commercial ISPs.
- Inveneo staff conducted a four-day training course focused on familiarising participants with Ubiquiti wireless kit and tower climbing practice. The training was well received.
- Problems were experienced with the Wireless Access Controllers, however these have now been resolved and a firewall has been established to prevent such problems occurring again.
- The microwave link at the Palo warehouse has been moved to ICRC premises where there is a 24-hour power supply. This has improved reliability of the internet link.

#### **ROXAS**



- ETC wireless services in Roxas have been decommissioned as humanitarian workers have now been migrated to local internet providers.
- Channel 4 of the VHF repeater will be activated this week for use by the UN and NGO community.

#### **ESTANCIA**

 The ETC is monitoring and assessing the restoration of local internet services in order to ascertain when users can be migrated from ETC services. It is likely that ETC services will continue until the end of February as commercial services remain unreliable.

# **Challenges and Gaps**

#### **ESTANICIA**

The local ISP is unreliable which may delay the decommissioning of the BT VSAT.

# **Planned Activities**

#### **ESTANCIA**

Work with PLDT to establish a reliable internet link.

#### **TACLOBAN**

Continued migration of users from ETC to local networks.
