

Republic of South Sudan (RoSS) ETC Situation Report #37 Reporting period 03/03/14 to 10/03/14

Highlights

- The ETC is planning to establish a radio room in the UNMISS compound in Bentiu in order to improve communication, staff tracking, and security for the humanitarian community.
- The ETC will install a generator, supplied by WFP, in the humanitarian camp in Mingkaman in order to ensure a continuous power supply and internet connection for humanitarian workers.

Cluster Responsibilities

• WFP is leading ETC activities in RoSS with responsibility for coordination, implementation and overall operational support for common ICT services.

Achievements

- A mission was deployed to Mingkaman on 07/03/14 to assess a faulty generator which powers the ETC internet kit in this location.
- A mission took placed in Bentiu on 05/03/2014 to retrieve repeaters and to conduct a needs assessment.
 The ETC is planning to establish a radio room in the UNMISS compound in Bentiu in order to improve communication, staff tracking, and security for the humanitarian community.
- The ETC continues to programme radios and allocate call signs to all NGOs and UN Agencies in South Sudan. This week, the ETC programmed 22 radios for both NGOs and UN Agencies. This makes it easier for humanitarian workers to communicate and improves security in the field.
- An ETC assessment mission took place in Nimule to verify the presence of NGOs and the need for ETC services. The assessment report is available to partners on request.
- Radio training for all new staff is ongoing and available upon request.
- Currently there are seven sites in South Sudan being provided with ETC internet connectivity.



Challenges and Gaps

- Insecurity and access constraints continue to impede the re-establishment of a VHF radio network in many key locations. VHF radio is essential to ensure the safety of humanitarian staff in the field.
- Two additional data solution kits are needed to provide internet in Lankien (Jonglei State) and Nasser (Upper Nile State).

Planned Activities

- The ETC assessment mission to Nasser has been delayed until further notice. The mission originally was planned for 07/03/2014 however had to be delayed due to security constraints.
- The ETC will install a generator, supplied by WFP, in the humanitarian camp in Mingkaman in order to ensure a continuous power supply and internet connection for humanitarian workers.
- The ETC is planning a mission to Kaya during the week of 10/03/2014 to ensure that internet connectivity is fully operational.
- The ETC continues to work on the SMS broadcasting platform which would be a tool available to the humanitarian community used to spread important messages via SMS.
- The VHF radio network will be re-established in Bentiu to improve communication and security for the humanitarian community there.

- The next Global ETC teleconference will be held on 17/03/14.
