Highlights

- WFP staff can now access the corporate network including WINGS and WFPgo in Cebu.
- Local ICT staff have been recruited and are now managing WFP ICT requirements in Tacloban.

Achievements

CEBU

- Sophos anti-virus software was installed on all WFP computers.
- WFP staff can now access the corporate network including WINGS and WFPgo.
- Ongoing ICT helpdesk support.
- A new ICT assistant was recruited.

TACLOBAN

- Local ICT staff have been recruited and are now managing WFP ICT requirements.
- Some WFP staff have been migrated to the local ISP PLDT for testing. Installation of a PLDT connection for the whole WFP office is ongoing.
- Three UPSs were installed to ensure continuous power supply for the WFP office.
- A server rack has been installed.
- An inventory of ICT equipment has been completed.
- Ongoing ICT helpdesk support.

GUIUAN

- Panda USB Vaccine was installed on WFP computers to prevent viruses.
- ArcGIS software has been installed for map production.
- Sophos anti-virus software was installed on all WFP computers.

- Telephony services are being provided to WFP staff.
- Ongoing ICT helpdesk support.

ROXAS

- The server was connected to a UPS to ensure continuous power supply.
- Ongoing ICT helpdesk support.

- WFP ICT equipment will be transferred from the Hotel Consuelo to prefab storage.
- A VHF base radio will be requested for the WFP office.
