

Philippines – Typhoon Haiyan ETC Situation Report #31 Reporting period 12/02/14 to 13/03/14

Highlights

- The ETC continues to scale down activities as local telecommunications services become available in an increasing number of areas. Humanitarian workers are being migrated from ETC wireless services to local ISPs and equipment is being demobilized and shipped out.
- ETC services are now being provided in 23 locations across seven towns and cities.

Achievements

CEBU

- ETC wireless internet services have been demobilised.
- ICT helpdesk support continues to be available for the humanitarian community.

GUIUAN

- The internet connection for Radio Bakdaw was disconnected as they finished their mission.
- There are approximately 80 daily active users of ETC wireless services.
- Internet connectivity is now being provided in five locations.
- Radio programming and training is ongoing.

TACLOBAN

- Eleven sites have so far been disconnected from ETC internet services and migrated to local providers. Twelve sites continue to utilise ETC wireless services.
 - o The ETC is aiming to disconnect two sites per week.
- There are approximately 270 daily active users.
- ICT helpdesk support is ongoing.
- An inventory process is ongoing so equipment that is not needed can be shipped out.



- Radio programming and training is ongoing.
- A NetHope VSAT was installed for World Vision International.

ROXAS

All ETC internet services have been demobilised and humanitarian workers are using local ISP.

ORMOC/ESTANCIA/BORONGAN

All ETC services have been demobilized.

BOGO CITY

A NetHope VSAT used by World Vision has been transported to Tacloban.

BURAUEN

• A NetHope VSAT was installed at the new Plan International office.

Challenges and Gaps

- The local internet connections in certain locations remain unreliable, which could delay the migration of agencies to local providers and thus demobilisation of ETC services.
- Generators and solar panels are still required in certain areas for backup electricity to ensure continued provision of IT and telecommunications services.

Planned Activities

TACLOBAN

Continued migration of users from ETC to local ISP or NetHope.
