

## **Republic of South Sudan (RoSS)**

### **ETC Situation Report #38**

**Reporting period 10/03/14 to 17/03/14**

#### **Highlights**

- The ETC has established internet connectivity in the UNHCR compound in Nimule where eleven humanitarian organizations are currently utilizing the services.

#### **Cluster Responsibilities**

- WFP is leading ETC activities in RoSS with responsibility for coordination, implementation and overall operational support for common ICT services.

#### **Achievements**

- The ETC has established internet connectivity in the UNHCR compound in Nimule where eleven humanitarian organizations are based.
- The ETC has re-established a VHF network in Bentiu for NGOs and UN agencies which can be accessed on channel 9. This radio network will assist partners in improving communication, staff tracking, and security for the humanitarian community.
- An assessment mission was conducted in Kaya on 11/03/2014 and found that maintenance was required on the emergency.lu internet connectivity kit. The ETC equipment was brought back to Juba for maintenance and will be deployed to another field location based on needs.
- Radio training for all new staff is ongoing and available upon request.
- Currently, there are seven sites in South Sudan being provided with ETC internet connectivity.

#### **Challenges and Gaps**

- Insecurity and access constraints continue to impede the re-establishment of a VHF radio network in many key locations. VHF radio is essential to ensure the safety of humanitarian staff in the field.

#### **Planned Activities**

- The ETC will install a generator, supplied by WFP, in the humanitarian camp in Mingkaman in order to ensure a continuous power supply and internet connection for humanitarian community; exact date TBC.

- The ETC is planning a security telecommunications maintenance mission to Aweil for 20/03/2014.
  - The ETC continues to work on the SMS broadcasting platform which would be a tool available to the humanitarian community used to spread important messages via SMS.
