Highlights

- WFP staff in Tacloban have now been migrated from the ETC network to the local ISP PLDT.
- Connectivity in the WFP office in Guiuan will be maintained as long as WFP remain in the premises. WFP staff are currently due to remain until 15/05/14.

Achievements

CEBU

- A Local Area Network was established at the WFP warehouse.

TACLOBAN

- WFP staff have now been migrated from the ETC network to the local ISP PLDT.
- The internet connection has now been transferred to a static IP address.
- A VHF base station was installed at the WFP office.
- VHF radio checks took place between the WFP office in Guiuan and the WFP office in Tacloban.
- Regular radio checks for WFP staff are ongoing.
- Spare parts for electric equipment and generators have been transferred from the warehouse to the WFP office.
- An inventory of equipment is ongoing.
- ICT Helpdesk assistance is ongoing.

GUIUAN

- Connectivity in the WFP office will be maintained as long as WFP remain in the premises. WFP staff are currently due to remain until 15/05/14.
- ICT Helpdesk assistance is ongoing.
- Radio checks for WFP staff are ongoing.

- Radio call sign lists have been updated.
- Ongoing maintenance of electrical equipment.

ROXAS

- Ongoing ICT helpdesk support.

CEBU

- A Local Area Network will be designed and installed for the new office, which is in the same building as the current office but is a bit smaller.

GUIUAN

- An inventory of equipment is ongoing.

TACLOBAN

- Connectivity at the WFP office in Palo will be disconnected.
