1. Update from Nepal

- The ETC is continuing to provide shared internet connectivity in 15x sites in Nepal.
 - ETC services in Bidur and Arughat will be disabled on 11 July (SES Ku-band satellite kits are currently installed in both locations).
- The new International Humanitarian Partnership (IHP) camp is now operational in Chautara and the ETC is providing internet connectivity via a link.
 - The ETC is aiming to move emergency.lu's Rapid Deployment Kit from the Humanitarian Hub to the IHP camp within one week.
- In line with the humanitarian action plan, the ETC will demobilize all its services in Nepal on 15 September.
 A needs assessment will take place on 1 September to determine whether this plan is realistic or whether some services need to be extended.

2. Updates from participants

emergency.lu

- emergency.lu asked whether there is suitable capacity on the ground to move the Rapid Deployment Kit to the IHP.
 - WFP noted that a team from Ericsson Response is on the ground to help do this and that they will be in regular contact with emergency.lu. A more detailed plan will be shared at a later date.

- The next local ETC Working Group meeting will be held tomorrow at 10:00 local time at the Humanitarian Staging Area.
