In the Central African Republic, the ETC supports the provision of common ICT services in 13 common operational areas, namely: Alindao, Bambari, Bangassou, Bangui, Birao, Batangafo, Bossangoa, Bouar, Bria, Kaga-Bandoro, N'Délé, Paoua and Zemio. The ETC is focusing on enhancing security telecommunications infrastructure throughout the country in collaboration with other agencies and the Telecommunications Security Standards (TESS) project.
