Highlights

- The first interim guidance document for Pacific Island Counties (PICs) outlining the use of digital health tools and systems in the response to COVID-19 is now available to view here.
- The ETC in the Pacific is providing technical expertise to support a UN Population Fund (UNFPA) telehealth project for communities on the remote outer Pacific islands.
- A new ETC Coordinator for the Pacific took up the post on 20 July.

ETC Activities

- The first interim guidance document for Pacific Island Counties (PICs) outlining the use of digital health
 tools and systems for the health sector response to COVID-19 is now available to view here. The guidance
 is the outcome of continued collaboration with the health services delivery team of the Joint Pacific
 COVID-19 Incident Management Team (IMT), led by WHO.
- The ETC in the Pacific provided technical expertise to a UN Population Fund (UNFPA) telehealth project
 involving service delivery for sexual and reproductive health services. The ETC advised on delivery modality
 solutions in the context of social distancing. When implemented, the telehealth service will cater to
 patients on remote outer Pacific islands, taking into consideration the context of COVID-19.



• A new ETC Coordinator for the Pacific took over the role on 20 July and is working remotely but in line with Pacific island office hours until travel to Fiji is possible.

Challenges

• COVID-19 travel restrictions are affecting the deployment of the new ETC Coordinator to Fiji.
