ETC activated 28 May 2021

The ETC was activated in Ethiopia in response to the crisis in Tigray on 28 May 2021 to provide ICT coordination, security communications services, assess options for the response community to access Internet connectivity services and to strengthen staff capacity.

The ETC is supporting or planning to support ICT services in key operational areas in Tigray, including Mekelle, Shire, Embamadre, Adigrat, Aksum, Maychew and Abiy Addi as part of the scale-up of the humanitarian response.
