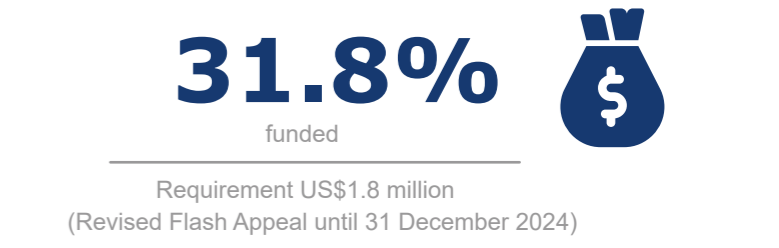


ETC ACTIVATED

31 October 2023
