The WFP-led Emergency Telecommunications Cluster (ETC) was activated on 31 October 2023 to meet the urgent need to support access to independent and reliable shared communications services for humanitarian organizations operating in Gaza. All planning for ETC services and activities are contingent on safe access to and within Gaza for personnel and equipment.
