





ETC ACTIVATED

18 September 2022

The ETC was activated in Somalia on 18 September after a one-month mission by an ETC coordinator to assess the ICT requirements to support the scale-up of the drought response. As of 30 October, planned ETC activities in Somalia are on hold due to a lack of cluster funding. WFP as the local ETC lead and global ETC lead agency continues to advocate for funding and ensure that critical ICT gaps are covered in the response.

Security communications services in 9 common operational areas



Internet connectivity in up to 3 hubs and 5 camps



An inter-agency common feedback mechanism (CFM).

Funding requirement



USD \$750,000 to urgently upgrade radio infrastructure

Out of a total **USD \$2 million** to implement all services
