



TUKASTAN EARTHQUAKE

ETC ACTIVATED

September 2023

At 03:32AM local time on 16 September, a 7.2 magnitude earthquake struck Ugrigk Mintaga, in central Northern Tukastan. The quake caused extensive damage, killing over 1200 people, injuring over 70,000 and affecting hundreds of thousands more. The ETC responded to President Al Hullein's request for international assistance by deploying a team of partners on 17 September to begin to assess the needs for communications for responders and the affected population. On 20 September the cluster was activated.
