The ETC has deployed VHF networks for UN security communications in Dnipro, Kyiv, and Odesa and is working to expand the network to Lviv and Mukachevo and set up a remote SOC system to link the network to UNDSS' Main SOC in Mukachevo. The cluster is also providing secure internet connectivity in three interagency humanitarian workspaces and is facilitating communication with the affected population through the ETC Chatbot
