Partnership Application

- The Global ETC received an application from iMMAP to become an ETC partner. The global coordinator and deputy coordinator met with an iMMAP representative in Dubai on two occasssions and strongly endorse their application as they could fill a need for operational support with IMO resources. All SAG members in attendance (and Oscar in advance of the meeting) felt iMMAP would be a suitable candidate to join the ETC.
- Some time will be given for a further review, but we anticipate having iMMAP present their organization to the larger ETC partnership in the new year to move the application process forward.
- Global coordinator provided some clarity on the due diligence process that WFP engages for NGO stand by partners.

NetHope SAG Membership Clarification

• It was clarified by Dag Brynjarsson that he would remain on the ETC SAG for the full duration of the 2-year term (unless indidacted otherwise during the term).

SIP - Next Steps

- It was agreed that the SAG should include a review of the current SIP at the in-person SAG meeting scheduled for February, 2023 in Rome.
- The SAG will recommend ways to revise the approach to ensure the objectives and goals are achievable and realistic. Recommendations will be shared with the full ETC partnership for review and endorsement.

ETC partnership model revision

- The discussion focused on the need to revise the ETC partnership model and consider the differet types of partner engagements with the ETC.
- The model should include some degree of designation for different partners, especially considering the vision to have more local partners included in the future.
- This will be a key topic to discuss at the in-person SAG meeting in Rome.
